Bomb-Making Materials Awareness Program (BMAP) Administrator Trainer (MGT-450-1)

The **Bomb-Making Materials Awareness Program (BMAP) Administrator Trainer** course equips supervisors, trainers, and other select representatives with the knowledge, skills, and abilities required to administer and sustain the BMAP within their communities. It will further prepare them to administer and teach the BMAP Community Liaison (CL) course.



Course Format and Audience

This is a three-day, in-person instructor-led training covering the following topics:

- Program goals
- Commercially available products used in HME/IED
- Reporting suspicious purchasing behaviors
- Resources and outreach
- Program development & implementation strategies

This course is designed for groups of up to 25 participants and is intended for public safety and private sector personnel tasked with administering the BMAP and instructing the BMAP Community Liaison course.
