# Vehicle-Borne Improvised Explosive Device Detection (PER-312)

The **Vehicle-Borne Improvised Explosive Device (VBIED) Detection** course provides participants with the knowledge and skills to successfully and safely inspect for, identify, and/or respond to vehicle-borne explosive threats.



## Course Format and Audience

This is a one-day, in-person instructor-led training covering the following topics:

- Vehicle-borne explosive threat overview
- Identifying vehicle-borne explosive hazards
- Assessment of vehicles and occupant behavior
- Vehicle inspection demonstration and activity

This course is designed for groups of up to 25 participants and is intended for audiences such as:

- Critical infrastructure owners and operators
- Public safety officers
- Emergency managers
- Security officers
- Law enforcement officers
- Private sector security professionals



## Accreditation
