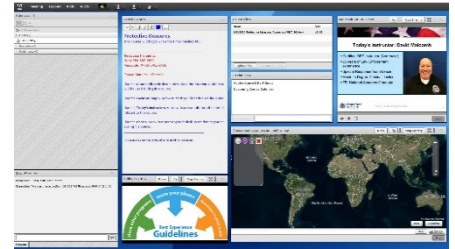




# Counter-IED Virtual Instructor-Led Training

**Virtual Instructor-Led Training (VILT)** courses provide general counter-improvised explosive device (C-IED) information to a broad audience via online training with a live instructor using the Homeland Security Information Network (HSIN) Adobe Connect platform. Perfect for participants with time availability constraints, most classes are approximately one hour in length. These courses are accredited by the International Association for Continuing Education and Training (IACET) and participants receive certificates with contact hours. All courses are provided free of charge.
