



ATM ATTACKS THREAT AWARENESS

Explosive attacks on automated teller machines (ATMs) by terrorists and criminals represent an ongoing threat. These attacks often result in significant property damage and an increased risk to bystanders. Learn to recognize these suspicious indicators.

COVERED SECURITY CAMERAS

Paint or tape may be used to cover up cameras.

TOOLS

Common tools may be used to access the ATM.

UNUSUAL DAMAGE

Burn marks, gouges, drill holes, or damaged locks are indications of tampering.

FUSE OR WIRE

Fuse or wire may be found near or protruding from the ATM.

HOSES OR TUBES

Hoses or tubes may be found near or protruding from the ATM.

TANKS OR BOTTLES

Camping fuel (such as propane), oxygen tanks, or acetylene bottles may be observed near the ATM.

OTHER SUSPICIOUS ITEMS

Fireworks, pipe bombs, and other items that appear out of the ordinary.



REPORT SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY
