The Improvised Explosive Device (IED) Explosive Effects and Mitigation course introduces the effects of an explosive detonation. It details the difference between blast, thermal/incendiary, and fragmentation effects, and describes the consequences on various targets. In addition, participants will learn about security measures and best practices that can help prevent or mitigate explosive effects.



Course Format and Audience

This 60-minute Virtual Instructor-led Training (VILT)* is delivered by a live instructor to cover the following topics:

- Blast, fragmentation and thermal effects
- Blast wave components resulting from a detonation
- Destructive consequences on structures/personnel
- Protective measures that mitigate explosive effects

* May be delivered in-person in some circumstances

This course is designed for small groups of up to 50 participants and is intended for audiences such as:

- Critical infrastructure owners and operators
- Public safety officers
- Emergency managers
- Security officers
- Law enforcement officials
- Private sector security professionals
