

Surveillance Detection Principles (AWR-940)

The **Surveillance Detection Principles** course provides participants with a topical knowledge and introductory skills to recognize hostile surveillance at facilities and events, and foundational knowledge for planning and responding appropriately.



Course Format and Audience

This four-hour, Virtual Instructor-led Training (VILT) is delivered by a live instructor to cover the following topics:

- Hostile Operations and the terrorist attack cycle
- Detecting hostile surveillance activity
- Vulnerability assessments and surveillance
- Hostile surveillance red zones and positions
- Five elements of a surveillance detection plan

This course is designed for small groups of up to 50 participants and is intended for audiences such as:

- Critical infrastructure owners and operators
- Public safety officers
- Emergency managers
- Security officers
- Law enforcement officers
- Private sector security professionals
