

# Improvised Explosive Device Search Procedures (PER-339)

The **Improvised Explosive Device (IED) Search Procedures** course introduces participants to basic, low risk search protocols. It provides participants the information needed to create a search plan for their facility or special event and allows them to preform IED seaches of a facility, an area, and a route.

# **Course Format and Audience**

This is a one-day, in-person instructor-led training covering the following topics:

- Preparing for a search
- Types of searches
- Facility search workshop
- Area search workshop
- Route search workshop
- Search assessment

This course is designed for groups of up to 25 participants and is intended for audiences such as:

- Critical infrastructure owners and operators
- Public safety officers
- Emergency managers
- Security officers
- Law enforcement officers
- Private sector security professionals
